



Dear GBBC Family,

Following the most recent emergency orders from our state Governor and the recommendations from the Center for Disease Control and Prevention, I would like to share some very important announcements concerning our congregation as we make every effort to negate the spread of the Coronavirus (COVID-19) in our church and community.

Please kindly note that effective immediately, we are suspending all our on-campus activities but we will resort to a virtual church model for the next two weeks. We recognize that this is such a fluid situation so we will take our measures on a bi-weekly basis and then reassess the situation before moving forward. We are therefore asking all our members to please stay at home for this period and connect with the church through our virtual platform which will be easily accessible for all members if you go on our website at www.glenburniebaptist.org. In practical terms, we are asking you to please note the following:

Our Sunday school and worship services for Sunday March 22 and Sunday March 29 have been suspended on campus but our worship services shall be streamed live at 11:00am.

Our morning and evening Wednesday Bible studies have been suspended on campus but we shall organize virtual Bible study and prayer meetings on Wednesdays from 6 – 7 pm beginning this Wednesday March 18.

All other events scheduled on campus within these two weeks such as our Business Meeting, Fellowship Breakfast, Women's Small Group Meetings etc. have all been suspended.

All necessary meetings within this period like Leadership Team meetings, Committee meetings etc. shall also be held virtually.

We will make adequate cleaning/sanitation arrangements to ensure that only our church staff and some needed volunteers will be on our campus to ensure that we better serve you during this period.

Please note that our ministry as a church is going to continue within this period hence our church office will remain open as usual and our staff will be available to serve you accordingly. This means even though we shall not gather on campus for corporate worship during this period, our giving still needs to continue. I am personally thankful for your generosity in the past months that have kept us on a good financial position and I am hopeful that you will still remain fervent in your generous contributions to the church for the work of the ministry.
