



Proverbs 28:13 (NASB95)

13 He who conceals his transgressions will not prosper, But he who confesses and forsakes *them* will find compassion.

14 How blessed is the man who fears always, But he who hardens his heart will fall into calamity.



Psalm 32:3–4 (NASB95)

3 When I kept silent *about my sin*, my body wasted away Through my groaning all day long. 4 For day and night Your hand was heavy upon me; My vitality was drained away *as with the fever heat of summer*.



Psalm 32:7 (NASB95)

7 You are my hiding place; You preserve me from trouble; You surround me with songs of deliverance.





Psalm 32:8–9 (NASB95)

8 I will instruct you and teach you in the way which you should go; I will counsel you with My eye upon you. 9 Do not be as the horse or as the mule which have no understanding, Whose trappings include bit and bridle to hold them in check.....



Proverbs 5:22–23 (NASB95)

22 His own iniquities will capture the wicked, And he will be held with the cords of his sin. 23 He will die for lack of instruction, And in the greatness of his folly he will go astray.





Isaiah 1:16–17 (NASB95)

16 “Wash yourselves, make yourselves clean;
Remove the evil of your deeds from My sight.
Cease to do evil, **17** Learn to do good; Seek
justice, Reprove the ruthless.....



Isaiah 1:18–20 (NASB95)

18 “Come now, and let us reason together,”
Says the LORD, “Though your sins are as
scarlet, They will be as white as snow;
Though they are red like crimson, They will
be like wool. 19 “If you consent and obey,
You will eat the best of the land; 20 “But if
you refuse and rebel, You will be devoured by
the sword.” Truly, the mouth of the LORD has
spoken.
