47 and that all this assembly may know that the LORD does not deliver by sword or by spear; for the battle is the LORD's and He will give you into our hands.”

Matthew 6:31–33 (NASB95)

31 “Do not worry.....32 for your heavenly *Father knows that you need all these things.*

1 John 1:9 (NASB95)

9 If we confess our sins, He is faithful and righteous to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

He will always forgive our sins!

God is the one who forgives, there is no place in scripture where it says we have to forgive ourselves.

Jeremiah 29:11 (NASB95)

11 'For I know the plans that I have for you,' declares the LORD, 'plans for welfare and not for calamity to give you a future and a hope.

He knows the plans: welfare, future & hope.

Romans 8:35 (NASB95)

35 Who will separate us from the love of Christ? Will tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword?

He loves us personally and unconditionally.

2 Corinthians 9:8 (NASB95)

8 And God is able to make all grace abound to you, so that always having all sufficiency in everything, you may have an abundance for every good deed;

He has all the grace we need.

What are His attributes?

Psalm 103:19 (NASB95)

19 The LORD has established His throne in the heavens, And His sovereignty rules over all.

Isaiah 46:9–10 (NASB95)

9 “Remember the former things long past, For I am God, and there is no other; *I am* God, and there is no one like Me, 10 Declaring the end from the beginning... *He is in control!*

He is always present.

Isaiah 41:10 (NASB95)

10 'Do not fear, for I am with you; Do not anxiously look about you, for I am your God. I will strengthen you, surely I will help you, Surely I will uphold you with My righteous right hand.' *He is always present.*

He is always the same.

Malachi 3:6 (NASB95)

6 “For I, the LORD, do not change;

Hebrews 13:8 (NASB95)

8 Jesus Christ *is* the same yesterday and today and forever.

He never changes.

He is always trustworthy.

2 Timothy 2:13 (NASB95)

13 If we are faithless, He remains faithful,
for He cannot deny Himself.

He is always trustworthy.

He is wise.

Romans 11:33 (NASB95)

33 Oh, the depth of the riches both of the wisdom and knowledge of God! How unsearchable are His judgments and unfathomable His ways!

Colossians 2:3 (NASB95)

3 in whom are hidden all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge. *He is wise.*

We must labor to know the truth!

The definition of labor means to work, especially hard, physical work!

Psalm 119:9–11 (NASB95)

9 How can a young man keep his way pure?
By keeping *it* according to Your word.

10 With all my heart I have sought You; Do not
let me wander from Your commandments. 11
Your word I have treasured in my heart, That I
may not sin against You. *Memorize*

1 Timothy 4:15–16 (NASB95)

15 Take pains with these things; be *absorbed* in them, so that your progress will be evident to all. 16 Pay close attention to yourself and to your teaching; persevere in these things, for as you do this you will ensure salvation both for yourself and for those who hear you. *Meditate*

1 John 1:3–4 (NASB95)

3 what we have seen and heard we proclaim to you also, so that you too may have fellowship with us; and indeed our fellowship is with the Father, and with His Son Jesus Christ. 4 These things we write, so that our joy may be made complete.

Fellowship

2 Corinthians 10:3–5 (NASB95)

3 For though we walk in the flesh, we do not war according to the flesh, 4 for the weapons of our warfare are not of the flesh, but divinely powerful for the destruction of fortresses. 5 *We are* destroying speculations and every lofty thing raised up against the knowledge of God, and *we are* taking every thought captive to the obedience of Christ.

Test thoughts thru the truth.

2 Timothy 4:2–4 (NASB95)

2 preach the word; be ready in season *and* out of season; reprove, rebuke, exhort, with great patience and instruction. 3 For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine; but *wanting* to have their ears tickled, they will accumulate for themselves teachers in accordance to their own desires, 4 and will turn away their ears from the truth and will turn aside to myths.
