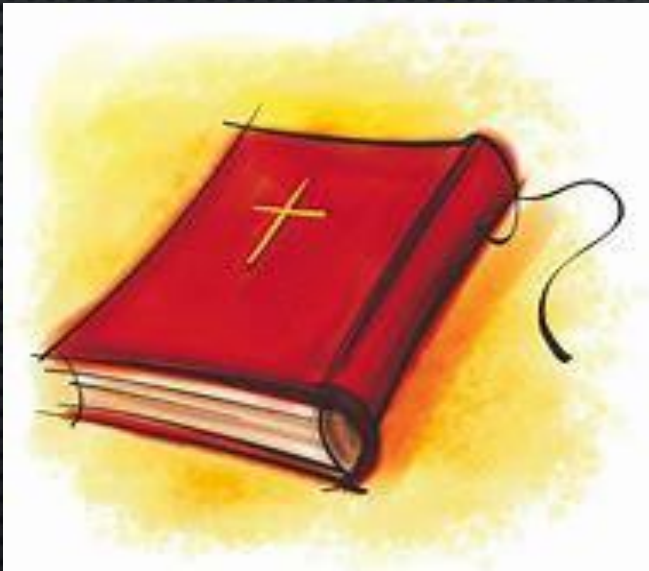

To The Scripture

Recipe for pancakes!

- 2 cups of flour
- 2 eggs
- Oil
- Baking powder
- Sugar
- Milk
- Thicker pancakes less, thinner more
- Pour in the pan
- Cooke at 350

In her book *God's Will For You Is Healing*, Gloria Copeland provides this recipe.

- Go to the Bible and find a Scripture that promises you healing.
- Second take your stand of faith upon that promise.
- Third confess out loud your faith in that promise.

- Fourth begin to act as though your healing is already done by looking at your situation not as it is but as it will be according to your promise.
- Act in faith by speaking life into your situation and not death.

1 John 3:8 (NASB)

⁸ the one who practices sin is of the devil; for the devil has sinned from the beginning. The Son of God appeared for this purpose, to destroy the works of the devil.

32 and you will know the truth, and the truth will make you free.”

- *The truth is the truth, it will not change.*
- *Unbelief is rejecting what God says is true.*
- *Belief is what one chooses to be true.*
- *Eve was deceived by the serpents craftiness.*
- *Her mind led astray.*
- *Astray from the simplicity & purity of the truth.*
- *It is the truth that will set us free.*

Acts 4:13 (NASB95)

Threat and Release

13 Now as they observed the confidence of Peter and John and understood that they were uneducated and untrained men, they were amazed, and *began* to recognize them as having been with Jesus.

Acts 4:19–20 (NASB95)

19 But Peter and John answered and said to them,
“Whether it is right in the sight of God to give heed to you
rather than to God, you be the judge; 20 for we cannot stop
speaking about what we have seen and heard.”

Acts 4:29–31 (NASB95)

29 “And now, Lord, take note of their threats, and grant that Your bond-servants may speak Your word with all confidence,
30 while You extend Your hand to heal, and signs and wonders take place through the name of Your holy servant Jesus.” 31 And when they had prayed, the place where they had gathered together was shaken, and they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and *began* to speak the word of God with boldness.

Mark 5:25–26 (NASB95)

25 A woman who had had a hemorrhage for twelve years, **26** and had endured much at the hands of many physicians, and had spent all that she had and was not helped at all, but rather had grown worse—

How do you act like your healed when it seems that things are getting worse.

Mark 5:27–28 (NASB95)

27 after hearing about Jesus, she came up in the crowd behind *Him* and touched His cloak. 28 For she thought, “If I just touch His garments, I will get well.”

- *We will have to push thru the crowd: crowd of doubts, push thru those who tell you that you can't, those who fight against you, those who place obstacles in your path.*
- *And just like the woman, push thru believing by faith that if you can touch the Word of God, you will get well.*

Mark 5:29–30 (NASB95)

29 Immediately the flow of her blood was dried up; and she felt in her body that she was healed of her affliction. 30 Immediately Jesus, perceiving in Himself that the power *proceeding* from Him had gone forth, turned around in the crowd and said, “Who touched My garments?”

The Recipe

- *Find the Scripture that addresses your situation.*
- *Take your stand of faith on that biblical promise.*
- *Confess out loud the promise: Faith comes by hearing...*
- *Remember there is life or death in the power of your tongue.*
- *By faith act that you are healed!*
