The proclamation of decrees which is based on Scripture is a tool given to us by God that is greatly overlooked.



## Isaiah 55:11 (NASB)

<sup>11</sup> So will My word be which goes forth from  
My mouth; It will not return to Me empty,  
Without accomplishing what I desire, And  
without succeeding *in the matter* for which I sent  
it.

When we face problems we can handle we look at success or failure based on what we can do and not what God can do.

- God is in heaven, Christ sits on His right hand and Christ left with us the Holy Spirit and we are to be the hands, the feet and the mouth of Jesus.



- So we can either be a part of the solution or a part of the problem.
- I don't like the direction we are going.
- I will never happen.
- What happens if we fail.
- There is no way possible that we can do this.

## James 3:5-10 (NASB)

<sup>5</sup> So also the tongue is a small part of the body, and *yet* it boasts of great things. See how great a forest is set aflame by such a small fire! <sup>6</sup> And the tongue is a fire, the *very* world of iniquity; the tongue is set among our members as that which defiles the entire body, and sets on fire the course of *our* life, and is set on fire by hell.



## James 3:5-10 (NASB)

<sup>7</sup> For every species of beasts and birds, of reptiles and creatures of the sea, is tamed and has been tamed by the human race. <sup>8</sup> But no one can tame the tongue; *it is* a restless evil *and* full of deadly poison. <sup>9</sup> With it we bless *our* Lord and Father, and with it we curse men, who have been made in the likeness of God;

## James 3:5-10 (NASB)

<sup>10</sup> from the same mouth come *both* blessing and cursing. My brethren, these things ought not to be this way.



The word decree is a legal term that can mean;

- An authoritative instruction provided by someone who has authority or by a government.
- A judgment decided by a court of law.

## **John 6:63-64 (NASB)**

<sup>63</sup> "It is the Spirit who gives life; the flesh profits nothing; the words that I have spoken to you are spirit and are life. <sup>64</sup> "But there are some of you who do not believe." For Jesus knew from the beginning who they were who did not believe, and who it was that would betray Him.



## **Hebrews 4:12 (NASB)**

<sup>12</sup> For the word of God is living and active and sharper than any two-edged sword, and piercing as far as the division of soul and spirit, of both joints and marrow, and able to judge the thoughts and intentions of the heart.

“For the Word of God is living and active and full of power [making it operative, energizing, and effective]”



## Isaiah 55:11 (NASB)

<sup>11</sup> So will My word be which goes forth from My mouth; It will not return to Me empty, Without accomplishing what I desire, And without succeeding *in the matter* for which I sent it.

- *If He said it, He will make it good!*

## **Job 22:28 (NASB)**

<sup>28</sup> "You will also decree a thing, and it will be established for you; And light will shine on your ways.



## Esther 8:8 (NASB)

<sup>8</sup> "Now you write to the Jews as you see fit, in the king's name, and seal *it* with the king's signet ring; for a decree which is written in the name of the king and sealed with the king's signet ring may not be revoked."

## **Psalm 23:5 (NASB)**

<sup>5</sup> You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies; You have anointed my head with oil; My cup overflows.



When we decree the Word of God in faith, we fill our cup in the spiritual realm with the power of God which in turns fills with a manifestation of His promises.

- *The Word of God that we decree attracts the manifestation ow what that specific Word proclaimed.*
- *Every Word we decree has God's power attached to it.*

Ten powerful decrees based on the Word of God.

- The Word we decree will not return void but will accomplish everything it is sent to do (Isaiah 55:11).
- The Word that we decree will dispatch angels to guard us as we becomes God's voice for His Word to be released in this earth (Psalm 103:20).



- Our decree of the Word of God will send forth light that will penetrate darkness and provide wisdom when understanding is needed (Psalm 119:130).
- Signs & wonders will accompany us as we decree the Word of God (Mark 16:12).
- When we decree the Word of God we can call into being things that were not (Romans 4:17).

- When we decree the Word of God no weapon formed against us will prevail (Isaiah 54:17).
- When we decree the Word of God, it is the Word that strengthens us (3:16).
- When we decree the Word of God it is like a seed that brings forth a harvest according to the nature of the seed (Mark 4:1-8).
