Genesis 37:3–4 (NASB95)

3 Now Israel loved Joseph more than all his sons, because he was the son of his old age; and he made him a varicolored tunic. 4 His brothers saw that their father loved him more than all his brothers; and *so* they hated him and could not speak to him on friendly terms.

Genesis 37:18 (NASB95)

The Plot against Joseph

18 When they saw him from a distance and before he came close to them, they plotted against him to put him to death.

John 10:10 (NASB95)

10 “The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; I came that they may have life, and have *it* abundantly.

1 Peter 5:8 (NASB95)

8 Be of sober *spirit*, be on the alert. Your adversary, the devil, prowls around like a roaring lion, seeking someone to devour.

Ephesians 6:12 (NASB95)

12 For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the powers, against the world forces of this darkness, against the spiritual *forces* of wickedness in the heavenly *places*.

Point #2

When You Fall Never Forget Who
You Are Fighting Against!

Genesis 37:26–27 (NASB95)

26 Judah said to his brothers, “What profit is it for us to kill our brother and cover up his blood? 27 “Come and let us sell him to the Ishmaelites and not lay our hands on him, for he is our brother, our *own* flesh.” And his brothers listened *to him*.

John 15:19 (NASB95)

19 “If you were of the world, the world would love its own; but because you are not of the world, but I chose you out of the world, because of this the world hates you.

Matthew 26:15 (NASB95)

15 and said, “What are you willing to give me to betray Him to you?” And they weighed out thirty pieces of silver to him.

Point #3

When You Fall Never Forget the
world will sell you out for 30 pieces
of silver.

Genesis 40:14–15 (NASB95)

14 “Only keep me in mind when it goes well with you, and please do me a kindness by mentioning me to Pharaoh and get me out of this house. 15 “For I was in fact kidnapped from the land of the Hebrews, and even here I have done nothing that they should have put me into the dungeon.”

Psalm 18:2 (NASB95)

2 The LORD is my rock and my fortress
and my deliverer, My God, my rock, in
whom I take refuge; My shield and the
horn of my salvation, my stronghold.

Psalm 27:13–14 (NASB95)

13 *I would have despaired* unless I had believed that I would see the goodness of the LORD In the land of the living. 14 Wait for the LORD; Be strong and let your heart take courage; Yes, wait for the LORD.

Point #4

When You Fall Never Put Your Trust
In People, Only Put Your Trust In
The Lord.

Genesis 39:2–3 (NASB95)

2 The LORD was with Joseph, so he became a successful man. And he was in the house of his master, the Egyptian. 3 Now his master saw that the LORD was with him and *how* the LORD caused all that he did to prosper in his hand.

They plotted to kill him.

- *He was thrown in a large hole.*
- *He was sold.*
- *He was lied about.*
- *He was placed into prison.*
- *No matter where he was the Lord was with him.*

Isaiah 41:10 (NASB95)

10 'Do not fear, for I am with you; Do not anxiously look about you, for I am your God. I will strengthen you, surely I will help you, Surely I will uphold you with My righteous right hand.'

Point #5

When You Fall Always Remember
That He Will Never Leave You Or
Forsake You And He Will Lift You
Back Up.

Genesis 41:39–40 (NASB95)

39 So Pharaoh said to Joseph, “Since God has informed you of all this, there is no one so discerning and wise as you are. 40 “You shall be over my house, and according to your command all my people shall do homage; only in the throne I will be greater than you.”

Proverbs 16:7 (NASB95)

7 When a man's ways are pleasing to the LORD, He makes even his enemies to be at peace with him.

Point #6

When You Fall And Feel Like Giving
Up, When Your Ways Are Pleasing
To The Lord, He Will Even Make
Our Enemies Have Favor With Us!

Genesis 45:4–5 (NASB95)

4 Then Joseph said to his brothers,
“Please come closer to me.” And they
came closer. And he said, “I am your
brother Joseph, whom you sold into
Egypt. 5 “Now do not be grieved or
angry with yourselves, because you
sold me here, for God sent me before
you to preserve life.

Genesis 50:20 (NASB95)

20 “As for you, you meant evil against me, *but* God meant it for good in order to bring about this present result, to preserve many people alive.

Romans 8:28 (NASB95)

28 And we know that God causes all things to work together for good to those who love God, to those who are called according to *His* purpose.
