





The Five Dumbest

21 So the LORD God caused a deep sleep to fall upon the man, and he slept; then He took one of his ribs and closed up the flesh at that place.


22 The LORD God fashioned into a woman the rib which He had taken from the man, and brought her to the man.

Proverbs 17:1 (NASB)


¹ Better is a dry morsel and quietness with it Than a house full of feasting with strife.

¹⁴ The beginning of strife is *like* letting out water, So abandon the quarrel before it breaks out.



¹ What is the source of quarrels and conflicts among you? Is not the source your pleasures that wage war in your members?



Number Seven: Honey As Long As We Have Been Married You Should Know What I Am Thinking.


Proverbs 26:20 (NASB)

- ¹⁹ how an eagle glides through the sky, how a snake slithers on a rock, how a ship navigates the ocean, how a man loves a woman.




How do we keep it all together?

⁸ Most important of all, continue to show deep love for each other, for love covers a multitude of sins.




How do we keep it all together?

- Second remember that God joined you together.

- **Matthew 19:4-6 (NLT2)**

⁵ And he said, ‘This explains why a man leaves his father and mother and is joined to his wife, and the two are united into one.’

⁶ Since they are no longer two but one, let no one split apart what God has joined together.”




How do we keep it all together?

- ¹⁶ Confess your sins to each other and pray for each other so that you may be healed. The earnest prayer of a righteous person has great power and produces wonderful results.




How do we keep it all together?




How do we keep it all together?

- ¹⁹ It's better to live alone in the desert than with a quarrelsome, complaining wife.




How do we keep it all together?


How do we keep it all together?
