**Proverbs 17:14 (NASB)**

### **James 4:1 (NASB)**

<sup>1</sup> What is the source of quarrels and conflicts among you? Is not the source your pleasures that wage war in your members?




# The Seven Dumbest Things That A Wife Can Say To Her Husband!

## **Proverbs 26:20 (NASB)**

## **Proverbs 30:18-19 (NLT2)**

- <sup>18</sup> There are three things that amaze me— no, four things that I don't understand:
- <sup>19</sup> how an eagle glides through the sky, how a snake slithers on a rock, how a ship navigates the ocean, how a man loves a woman.



How do we keep it all together?

- First keep the courtship going.

**1 Peter 4:7-8 (NLT2)**

<sup>7</sup> The end of the world is coming soon. Therefore, be earnest and disciplined in your prayers.

<sup>8</sup> Most important of all, continue to show deep love for each other, for love covers a multitude of sins.





How do we keep it all together?

- Second remember that God joined you together.

- **Matthew 19:4-6 (NLT2)**

<sup>5</sup> And he said, ‘This explains why a man leaves his father and mother and is joined to his wife, and the two are united into one.’

<sup>6</sup> Since they are no longer two but one, let no one split apart what God has joined together.”



How do we keep it all together?

- Third pray together.

- **James 5:16 (NLT2)**

- <sup>16</sup> Confess your sins to each other and pray for each other so that you may be healed. The earnest prayer of a righteous person has great power and produces wonderful results.



How do we keep it all together?

- Fourth never go to bed angry.

- **Ephesians 4:25-27 (NLT2)**

<sup>25</sup> So stop telling lies. Let us tell our neighbors the truth, for we are all parts of the same body. <sup>26</sup> And “don’t sin by letting anger control you.” Don’t let the sun go down while you are still angry, <sup>27</sup> for anger gives a foothold to the devil.
