Luke 23:26 (NASB) <sup>26</sup> When they led Him away, they seized a man, Simon of Cyrene, coming in from the country, and placed on him the cross to carry behind Jesus.

Christianity is not a spectator sport!

Matthew 21:9 (NASB) <sup>9</sup> The crowds going ahead of Him, and those who followed, were shouting, "Hosanna to the Son of David; BLESSED IS HE WHO COMES IN THE NAME OF THE LORD; Hosanna in the highest!"

John 19:6 (NASB) <sup>6</sup> So when the chief priests and the officers saw Him, they cried out saying, "Crucify, crucify!" Pilate \*said to them, "Take Him yourselves and crucify Him, for I find no guilt in Him."

### Mark 15:11-13 (NASB)

<sup>11</sup> But the chief priests stirred up the crowd to ask him to release Barabbas for them instead. <sup>12</sup> Answering again, Pilate said to them, "Then what shall I do with Him whom you call the King of the Jews?"<sup>13</sup> They shouted back, "Crucify Him!"

How Close Are You Willing To Get To The Cross?

- Preconceived expectations
- Unfulfilled restorations
- Misunderstood anticipations
- A change in validations

One breath they praise Him the second breath the want to crucify Him!

**Revelation 3:15-16 (NASB)** <sup>15</sup> 'I know your deeds, that you are neither cold nor hot; I wish that you were cold or hot. <sup>16</sup> 'So because you are lukewarm, and neither hot nor cold, I will spit you out of My mouth.

**1 John 2:15 (NASB)**<sup>15</sup> Do not love the world nor the things in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him.

Titus 1:16 (NASB) <sup>16</sup> They profess to know God, but by their deeds they deny Him, being detestable and disobedient and worthless for any good deed.

Luke 6:46 (NASB) <sup>46</sup> "Why do you call Me, 'Lord, Lord,' and do not do what I say?

2 Corinthians 13:5 (NASB) <sup>5</sup> Test yourselves to see if you are in the faith; examine yourselves! Or do you not recognize this about yourselves, that Jesus Christ is in you—unless indeed you fail the test?

Isaiah 29:13 (NASB) <sup>13</sup> Then the Lord said, "Because this people draw near with their words And honor Me with their lip service, But they remove their hearts far from Me, And their reverence for Me consists of tradition learned by rote, [meaning habitual repetition]

## Three ways to know if you are a luke warm Christian.

- First you don't seek God before you make decisions.
- Second your friends don't take your walk seriously.
- Third you want to know how far you can push the limits with God.

The cross is a sign of perfection, how close are you willing to get to the cross? Matthew 16:24 (NASB) <sup>24</sup> Then Jesus said to His disciples, "If anyone wishes to come after Me, he must deny himself, and take up his cross and follow Me.

### Mark 15:21 (NASB)

<sup>21</sup> They \*pressed into service a passer-by coming from the country, Simon of Cyrene (the father of Alexander and Rufus), to bear His cross.

Could *they* have been *Him*, nothing happens by coincidence?

Matthew 16:24 (NASB) <sup>24</sup> Then Jesus said to His disciples, "If anyone wishes to come after Me, he must deny himself, and take up his cross and follow Me.

Man is to deny his whole self, all his natural motives & impulses so far as they come into conflict with the claims of Christ.

How Close To The Cross Are You Willing to Come?

If you follow Jesus you will be required at some point in time in that journey to pick up the cross.

The real question is how close are you willing to get to the cross?
