

Easter Versus Covid: And the Winner Is...

Believe it or not, Easter and the Covid-19 virus have some things in common! Let's consider a couple ways that Easter and Covid have influenced our lives:

- Easter and Covid are both real, whether you like it or not.
 - Easter happened 2,000 years ago, <u>changing everything</u>. God broke into history in the life, death and resurrection of Jesus in order to save us from our foolish lives in which we ignored God and lived selfishly. This is the best news ever, even if you don't see it in the mainstream media every day. God's love for you is real; the question is, have you accepted his gift in Jesus Christ?
 - Covid happened in 2020, and whether you like it or not, it <u>changed everything</u>. No matter where you live, no matter who you vote for, no matter what your religion, race or creed—Covid upset your apple cart! You can try to ignore it, but that's pretty impossible these days.
- You ignore Easter and Covid at your own peril.
 - Let's start with <u>Covid</u>: While we've learned that Covid is not fatal for most people, it can still make you sick, get you quarantined for 14 days, and in rare cases (often in combination with other serious "co-morbidities") cause death. And—no matter who you are, the Covid mandates will affect your daily life.
 - What about <u>Easter</u>: Easter has the potential to affect (infect?) everyone, if they are willing to believe its message that God raised Jesus from the dead! This will definitely affect your daily life, because you now realize that no matter what else happens do you—even Covid—God has promised you eternal life!

Because of Easter, we can put Covid 19 (and every other disaster, defeat or danger) in proper perspective.

Easter is God interrupting our Covid-driven lives to create a new normal—a <u>new</u> life! We live in a world obsessed with the latest disaster, defeat or danger. Covid is really nothing new; it's just the latest bad news that tries to defeat us. Someday it will be a distant memory (yes, it will!).

But Easter will continue to be "good news" that gives us <u>hope</u>, <u>peace</u> and <u>a future</u>! So join with us, and "Find Hope This Easter"! Because God has interrupted our messy world, and in his power he is making all things new!

The hidden surprise in these sweet rolls hints at the reason behind Easter's joy.

What you need:

- ½ cup chopped pecans
- 10 uncooked frozen rolls, thawed
- 10 large marshmallows
- ½ cup sugar
- 1 tsp cinnamon
- ½ cup melted butter
- ¼ cup brown sugar
- Adult help

What you do:


- 1. Grease a round baking dish. Sprinkle pecans on the bottom.
- 2. Flatten each roll. Place a marshmallow in the center, wrap dough around it and pinch edges together.
- 3. Combine sugar and cinnamon. Dip each roll into melted butter and coat with cinnamon-sugar. Place in pan, seam side down.
- 4. Sprinkle brown sugar and remaining butter over rolls. Cover with plastic wrap and let rise 30 minutes.
- 5. Bake at 350 degrees until golden brown, about 30 minutes. Cool in pan.
- 6. As you bite into a roll, you'll see the marshmallow has melted, leaving an empty center just like Jesus' empty tomb!


We will be having Muffins with Moms on Sunday, April 18th at 10:00am in the Fellowship Hall.




Thank you to Dana Krumrey for all her years of volunteering for McPrayer! She has been a faithful leader for many years.
