What Does 150 Years Feel Like?

Our church is celebration its 150th birthday! We'll have a 150th Anniversary Celebration Sunday on October 10th. I hope you will be in town and can celebrate with us as we look back at some important memories and milestones, but also continue to look forward to the mission that God continues to entrust to us!

The official name for a 150th anniversary is a "sesquicentennial". That's a mouthful! (But feel free to use it to impress your friends!) If we think of a "generation as around 25-30 years, that's five or six generations of baptisms, confirmations, ministry events, weddings, funerals—and more!



In those 150 years since 1871, the "Methodist" churches in the United States have experienced several church splits and mergers: In 1871, Minnesota Methodists were part of The Methodist Episcopal Church (in the northern USA); in 1939, a merger with two other Methodist denominations resulted in The Methodist Church. In 1968 The Methodist Church and The Evangelical United Brethren Church joined to become The United Methodist Church.

And as you read this, we are probably about one year from another church division which will result in two (or even three) Methodist denominations once again, and Windom First United Methodist Church will be deciding which of those groups to affiliate with.

Meanwhile, local ministry will continue, and probably look similar in many ways. The changes that will happen in our local church will be the result of a changing culture and changing technology, along with learning how to help a new generation hear the old message of God's love, redemption, and abundant life here, and eternal life in the world to come! It is the most important, most relevant mission in the world, because we are partnering with the Creator of the universe to help each new generation find purpose, significance, and LIFE in Jesus Christ!

So please plan to join us on Sunday, October 10th at 10:30 during our morning worship service. This will be followed by a lunch in the fellowship hall where we will continue to share memories about the people, pastors, and events that shaped our church, our community and our lives today.

The generations before us often lived their faith and made sacrifices so that we could experience God's love and grace today. Their legacy is a great gift to us and future generations. My prayer is that our generation, the current members of First United Methodist Church in Windom, will live, learn, grow, sacrifice and give in such a way that we, too, will leave a lasting legacy for generations yet to come.

O may all who come behind us find us faithful!



Poinsettia Order Form



WE SET SAIL ON RALLY DAY!


Our rally day and first day of Sunday school was held September 12th. What a great day it was! The halls were filled with kids and adults coming in for the 9:00 Sunday school hour!
