

Easter: All or Nothing!

Has Easter got you in trouble yet? Caused you pain or embarrassment? Inconvenienced you (or your plans or goals)?

If not, you may not be taking Easter seriously enough. I mean it! Easter is "All or Nothing"! There's no in-between, if you really "get" Easter.

Easter—the Christian Church's central truth and foundation (that Jesus, who died on the cross, was raised from the grave with a real, new eternal body) is a life disturbing reality.

Why? Because, if true, it means this life is not all there is, this life is barely the beginning of what we were created for! So—if you and I are living for short-term, this-world goals and plans, we're making a very bad investment of our lives on this side of the grave!

But we often do this—even in the church! To steal a quote from Joni Eareckson Tada; "Have you noticed how people try to tame the resurrection of Jesus with sentimental images of lilies, cherubs, and bluebirds? Could it be that we've lost touch with the shocking reality of what happened on that Sunday morning? Only minutes before Mary Magdalene arrived at the tomb, this Man was stiff, gray, and stone-cold dead—a battered corpse like you might see under a sheet in a police morgue... then the dead Man... walked out of the grave..."

If that doesn't give you chills, nothing will. Death is no longer something to fear; death is no longer a limitation for those who have come to terms with that Man walking out of that grave. It means God has broken the chains and bondage of death.

And it means on Easter Sunday—Resurrection Day!—Christians cannot be complacent and complicit with bunnies, lilies and colored eggs. We have new Life to live; we have a Message to share, we have a Power to employ in changing our lives and awaking all the "dead" around us so they can receive that Promise and Power as well!

Easter will get you in trouble; it will change your plans and goals—but it will set you free and dare you to be "resurrected" right now, and see how you can rattle your world—for good, and forever. That's Easter—All or Nothing!

I want to invite you to join Kathy Jo and me for an upcoming Global Methodist Church event, called the New Hope Conference. The theme is "For Such A Time as This" (from Esther 4:14). It's happening April 21-22, (Friday evening to Saturday noon) in Fargo, ND. CHURCH CONFERENCE There will be a Church Conference on **April 23rd** following the worship service in the sanctuary. It is part two of the Church Conference meetings held approving the disaffiliation agreement. This authorizes the funds and implementation of all other aspects of the disaffiliation agreement, upon ratification by the MN Annual Conference at their annual session, and further authorizes the Board of Trustees to take all steps required or reasonably necessary to implement the approved disaffiliation agreement. This vote again will be extended to all professing members present. It will be presided over by Pastor Mike McInnis as designated by our District Superintendent. The resolution will need to be approved by a 2/3 majority vote of those present.

The words **PAID IN FULL** must be indicated in order for your gift to be applied correctly. As of 3/20/23 your generous giving has brought in \$10,740. We have \$88,838.42 to go! Blessing to you from the Finance Committee.




Outreach Yard Signs


If you saved your "Find Hope This Easter" yard sign from previous Easters, please try to place it in your yard again now through Easter.




