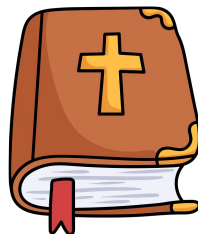

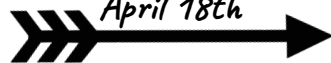

Key Points to explore:

- God can overcome any obstacle
- God has a good plan for us and He can overcome any obstacle
- Kids will learn they can remember His great power, and trust Him when they face obstacles in their lives

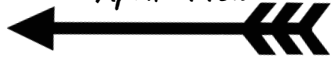
Discipleship conversation starter for Parents:

Key Verses to explore: Joshua 3-4

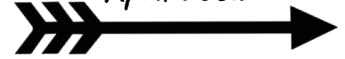

- God always answers prayers with what is best for us

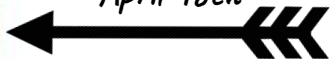
Discipleship conversation starter for Parents:

Key Verses to explore: Joshua 9-10

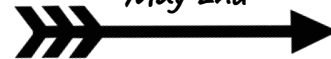

Key Points to explore:

- God uses people to accomplish his plan

Discipleship conversation starter for Parents:

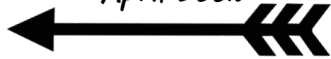
