




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What is your biggest dream that you wish would come true? What are you doing to help your dream come true? (discuss the idea at dinner!)

Key Points to explore:

- God responds to our prayers

Discipleship conversation starter for Parents:

The Bible tells us God hears every prayer! As a family share a time that when you felt God heard your prayers. Spend time praising God for answering all your prayers, even in ways you didn't plan for!

Key Points to explore:

- God uses people to accomplish his plan
 - Kids will learn that we can trust God to work all things together for his plan.
 - Kids will learn that God wants to use us, and when we are faithful, He can do great things through us.

<u>Discipleship conversation starter for Parents:</u>

Play the game "would you rather" to deepen relationships. Play alongside your kids, making sure your choices are also know. Building relationships with simple choices, will make it easier for you kids to seek your advice when the choices get hard.
