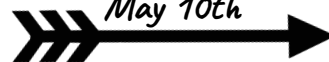




## *Week #1: Travels of the Ark*

- Kids will learn because God is all powerful, they can trust that He has a plan for them

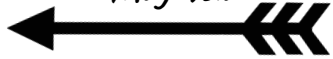
### Discipleship conversation starter for Parents:

Key Verses to explore:      1 Samuel 4-6

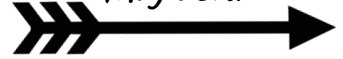

### Discipleship conversation starter for Parents:

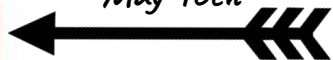
What is one thing you want to change about your day and why?

Key Verses to explore: 1 Samuel 17



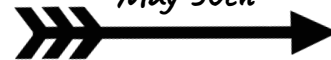

### Discipleship conversation starter for Parents:

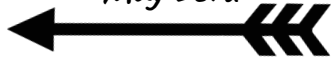
What is something you are really looking forward to do that you can't do today? Is it hard or easy to wait?

## Week #4: David & Mephibosheth

### Key Points to explore:

- Kids will learn how they can show God's grace and kindness to one another and not worry about the future!

### Discipleship conversation starter for Parents:

Tell a story of a time that things turned out different then you had planned. How did you rely on God during that time? How did things work out, even though it wasn't as planned?
