Key Points to explore:



- God is all powerful; He alone is God
- Nothing is stronger than God
- Kids will learn because God is all powerful, they can trust that He has a plan for them

Discipleship conversation starter for Parents:

How could remembering what is true about God help you when you are happy, sad or afraid?

Key Verses to explore:

1 Samuel 4-6





Week #2: David and Goliath

Next Week May 23rd

Key Points to explore:

- God is trustworthy
- God will fight on behalf of His faithful people
- Even when facing impossible odds, we can think about the story of David and know that God is with us.

Discipleship conversation starter for Parents:

What is one thing you want to change about your day and why? Discuss it as a family at dinner. Remember as parents, participate by answering the question too!

Key Verses to explore: 1 Samuel 17

Key Points to explore:

- God is faithful
- Kids will learn when they serve God, He delights in making a way for them!

<u>Week #3: David's Kingship</u>

Kids will learn that they do not need to worry because they know that God is faithful to always keep His promises.

Discipleship conversation starter for Parents:

What is something you are really looking forward to do that you can't do today? Is it hard or easy to wait? Do you think it was easy for David to wait to be king? (cue Lion King Music)

Week #4: David & Mephibosheth



Key Points to explore:

- God's plan involves his kindness
- God cares about the details of our lives.
- Kids will learn how they can show God's grace and kindness to one another and not worry about the future!

Discipleship conversation starter for Parents:

Tell a story of a time that things turned out different then you had planned. How did you rely on God during that time? How did things work out, even though it wasn't as planned?
