Week #1: God's Plan is Unstoppable

Key Points to explore:

- Story of the week: Nehemiah rebuilt the city walls of Jerusalem
- God's plan is unstoppable

God is strong and NOTHING can STOP him from keeping his PROMISES!

Discipleship conversation starter for Parents:

Doing right to and for others is God's plan. How could you know what God wants you to do when others are trying to stop you from doing what is right?

Key Verses to explore:

Nehemiah 2; 4; 6:1-15; 12:27 & 43

Week #2: Isaiah's Temple Vision



Key Points to explore:

- God invites us to respond to him
- Kids will learn that God invites His people to respond to His call and to accomplish His plan.

God invites us to be His messengers of His love and forgiveness to others

Discipleship conversation starter for Parents:

When what we say doesn't match what we do, people stop believing us. News about God's love and forgiveness is important to tell. Do you confuse people with this message? How? What can you change?

Key Verses to explore: Isaiah 6:1-8

Week #3: God is powerful and with us

Key Points to explore:

- God is powerful and with us
- God is with us and is in control, no matter what the circumstances.
- God is powerful and we can live in a way that honors God.



<u>Discipleship conversation starter for Parents:</u>

How do you know someone really loves you? What does this person do? Do you believe God loves you? Name a person who has shown you God's love through their actions!

Key Verses to explore: Daniel 3

Week #4: God is in control

Key Points to explore:

 Even in difficult situations, God is in control and we never need to doubt that He has a bigger plan.

- God is in control
- Do not worry or be scared because God is in control

Discipleship conversation starter for Parents:

When Daniel was 80 years old, he stood up to a bully who could of bullied and killed him. When you stand up to a bully, how can you remember God is bigger and in control?
