THROUGH JESUS WE CAN BE FORGIVEN OF OUR SINS AND BECOME HOLY IN GOD'S SIGHT. WE'RE CALLED TO MAKE ROOM IN OUR HEARTS AND LIVES FOR JESUS.

## Church Library Book Review






