I. The Climax is the True Christ’s Return! (Matt. 24:29 – 30)

- A. Visible/Physical (Acts 1:10 – 11)
- B. Every eye will witness the event (Rev. 1:7)
- C. With power and great glory & physical signs of His coming

II. The Comparison of the First and Second Coming of the True Christ (Rev. 19:11 – 16)

A. The First Coming of Christ:

- 1) The lamb of God (John 1:29)
- 2) Suffers for the sins of the world (I John 3:5, 2:2)
- 3) Came to save the lost (John 3:16)
- 4) Came to show the Love of God (I John 3:16-18)
- 5) Rejected by all (John 1:11)

B. The Second Coming of Christ:

- 1) Lion of Judah - Riding on a white horse “faithful and true”
- 2) Judges sin and sinners – “Judges and wages war”
- 3) Comes to reign – “eyes...crowns...robe”
- 4) Complete the wrath of God – “Word...strike down”
- 5) Coming with the Armies of God

III. The Conclusion of The War of Armageddon (Rev. 19: 17 – 21; 2 Thess. 2:8)

- A. As the armies of the world gather to destroy the Jewish remnant
- B. They cry out to God and accept Christ’s offer of salvation with repentance and God hears them!
- C. The “great supper of God” – the kings of the earth against the rider on the white horse
- D. The beast is captured with the false prophet - thrown “ALIVE” in the fiery lake of burning sulfur
- E. The rest of the people were destroyed with a word out of the mouth of Christ!

IV. The Challenge of Easter (Matt. 28:1 – 7)

- A. Seven comparisons to consider – The True Christ and the Antichrist
- B. Jesus resurrection as the beginning – The Antichrist will suffer eternally in hell – the end.
- C. The True Christ offers you eternal life today – every person must decide
- D. Come and see for yourself! – Look at the evidence – make your decision!
