I. Mothering is Mentoring

- A. To raise our children is to provide for their basic needs as humans
- B. To mentor our children is to inspire their character and values
- C. Paul is in the multiplication business (I Cor. 11:1; Tit. 1:4) "Titus, my true son"
- D. "Likewise" Older women should mentor younger women

II. Modeling Maturity (Titus 2:3)

- A. Testimony "Reverent" holy lifestyle in relationship with God
- B. Tongue "not slanderers" (diabolos) not malicious gossip
- C. Temperance "not addicted to much wine" flesh controlled
- D. Teaching "Teach what is good" able to disciple others

III. Methodology in Mentoring (Titus 2;4,5)

- A. "Then they can urge young women" (sophronizo 1x = encourage to wisdom)
- B. Motherhood mentoring in these five areas:
 - 1) How to love your husband and children (philos)
 - 2) How to stay in self-control (2 Tim. 1:7)
 - 3) How to be modest and avoid carnality
 - 4) How to keep your home in order
 - 5) How to practice kindness in life (agathos) (Gal. 5:22)
 - 6) How to practice submission to your husband (Eph. 5:21)
- C. The ultimate goal: The Word of God is not "maligned" (blasphemeo)
