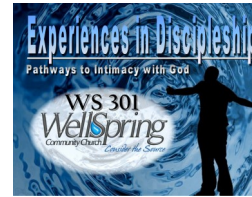

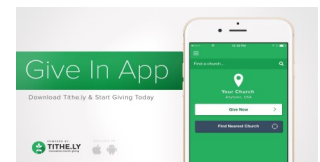
The Mathew 19 Fund

WellSpring Core Practices

1. Prayer
