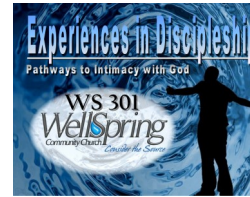

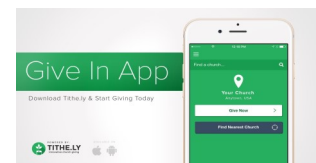


The Mathew 19 Fund
