3. The Holy Spirit

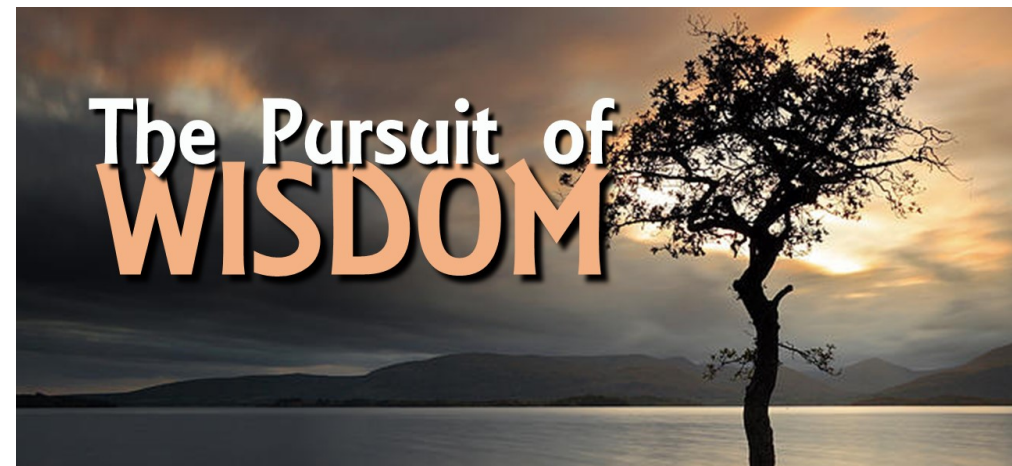
