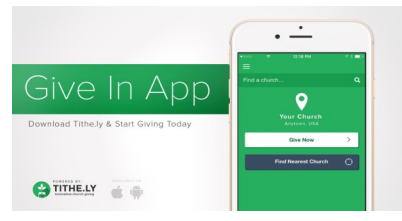

1. Prayer
