I. The Message of our Lives

- A. We are a reflection of what we believe in (Prov. 23:7)
- B. Out of the heart the mouth speaks (Matt. 12:34)
- C. We will be judged for the fruit of our lives (2 Cor. 5:10; Matt. 7:16)
- D. We are ambassadors of Christ! We take responsibility (Eph. 5:15)

II. The Message of our Lips

- A. **<u>Repentance</u>**: "...committed to us the message of reconciliation" (2 Cor. 5:19b)
- B. The Gospel from 2 Cor. 5:14 21
 - 1. vs. 14 <u>**Real Love**</u>: Christ's <u>love</u> to all
 - 2. vs. 14 <u>**Redemption**</u>: "One <u>died</u> for all and therefore all died"
 - 3. vs. 21- <u>Righteousness</u>: "God made him who had no sin to be sin for us"
 - 4. vs. 15 <u>Reprioritize</u>: "that those who live should <u>no longer live for</u> <u>themselves but for Christ"</u>
 - 5. vs. 17 **<u>Regeneration</u>**: "If anyone is in Christ, he is a <u>new creation</u>"
 - 6. vs. 19 <u>**Reconciliation:**</u> "God is reconciling the world to himself in Christ" vs. 20b – "We implore you on Christ's behalf: <u>**Be reconciled to God**</u>"
