  - vs. 20b – “We implore you on Christ's behalf: **Be reconciled to God**”







# WellSpring Core Practices

## 1. Prayer

Prayer is the heartbeat of the Christian life. It is the source of our joy and the encouragement of truth in a world that is often upside down. In all our ministries we make a commitment to study, teach, and memorize the living Word of God as contained in the Bible.
