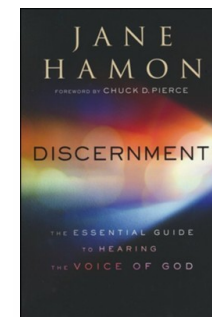

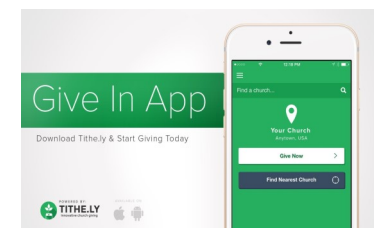

1. Prayer
