## I. The Background

- A. Joseph went through many trials and tribulations
  - Jealousy (37:3-7)

Betrayal (37:19 – 28)

Slavery (37:36)

Imprisonment (39:11,12)

Forgotten (40:23)

Reverence (50:17,18) Reunited (45:3; 46:30) Restored (41:41) Released (41:14) Remembered (41:14)

B. God <u>protected</u> and <u>strengthened</u> His people in Egypt through Joseph's care (46:2-4)

70 people entered Egypt (46:27)

430 years later – at least 30,000 and possibly up to 2 million depart Egypt

- C. The death of Jacob was the final test (49:33)
- D. Joseph's brothers fell down in front of Joseph as the Lord told him (50:16 18;37:6-8)

## <u>II. The "But God" Moment (Gen. 50:19 – 20)</u>

- A. You don't have to fear when God is in control! (Do not fear-365x)
- B. I am NOT God I am not in control!
- C. You intended evil for me, but God INTENTED good for many (Rom. 8:28)
  - 1. Character development
  - 2. Faith strengthening/testing
  - 3. Testimony to lead others to Christ
  - 4. Life and hope for the lost

## <u>III. The "But God" Lessons for Today</u>

A. God does NOT take us OUT, BUT GOD takes us through the trials and tribulations

- B. The world rewards the powerful, BUT GOD rewards the faithful (Gen. 39:21)
- C. Man makes plans, BUT GOD is sovereign (Isa. 55:8,9; Prov. 16:9,21)
