The church council met May 2, 2016 at 7:30 p.m. with the following persons present: Greg Johnson, Sam Schmidt, Carole Johnson, Sandy Husar, Rachel Wise and Mona Tanksley. Also present was Pastor Eldal.

Greg called the meeting to order and gave the devotions. The minutes were read and approved. Pastor presented his report for April listing the activities that he participated in. The Profit and Loss statement was reviewed for the first four months of the year. It shows that expenses exceeded income by \$661.25.

<u>Old Business:</u> Some information has been received on the listening devices that were talked about last month, however it was decided to obtain some more information regarding these units. We have received two bids for the furnaces which were reviewed. We discussed having a special congregational meeting in July to discuss the furnaces and air conditioners. The council will continue their discussions on this project next month and more information will be forthcoming.

New Business:

<u>Property Committee:</u> It was noted the hoist in the van is not working properly and this will be checked on. A light and chair have been purchased for Pastor's office. Since mice continue to be a problem in the building, Greg agreed to contact an exterminator to come and check out the problem.

<u>Evangelism Committee:</u> Rachel presented the committee's report noting that they met prior to the council meeting. It was decided that a praise service will be held the second Sunday of the month beginning this month, the same day the Sunday School children sing. It was reported that Gerald Groene will not be able to provide rolls for the coffee hour after the worship service for three weeks this month. Some members will be asked to provide coffee cakes or rolls to serve instead. It was noted that we need some help in putting up and taking down the Vacation Bible School decorations.


