One would catch a hint of His birth as early as Genesis three when God spoke of a descendent of Eve who would one day crush the serpent's or Satan's head.

There would be yet another glimpse of His coming in Genesis, when Abraham would prophecy that the ruler's scepter would never depart Judah.

This would be followed up in II Samuel, with a promise to David, a descendent of Judah, that his house or line would reign forever.

Other early hints of his birth would be in Isaiah, when the prophet would write of a child to be born whose name would be "Immanuel," and a coming "Prince of Peace," and "Wonderful Counselor."

Isaiah would also go on to describe one who would die as an atoning sacrifice for our sins but then see the light of life again.

He would of course, do all this to be a loving Savior and Messiah to you and me, so that we might be forgiven and have eternal life.

This Christmas season as we remember this long planned birth of Jesus and delight in the love expressed in his death and resurrection for us, may we be filled with love for him, and may we freshly entrust our lives to him as Savior and Lord.



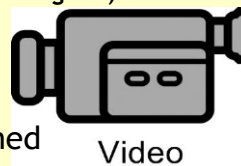

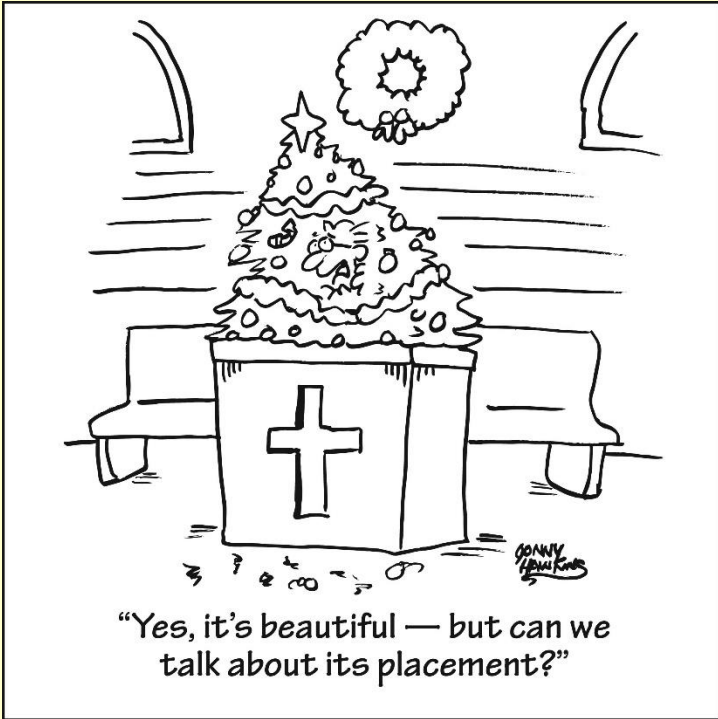
