FIRST LUTHERAN CHURCH SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

The First Evangelical Lutheran Church in Oakland, Nebraska is committed to making an ongoing impact in the life of youth in the community and the church family. We are also committed to creating an "on-going" and "out-going" impact in the life of high school youth who are members of our congregation. We believe that young people who have given to the ministry of this church during their high school years, should have an opportunity to benefit from scholarship opportunities to help find their calling and God's continuing purpose in their lives.

This scholarship is a **memorial scholarship**, given in memory of members of First Lutheran Church who demonstrated a commitment to church involvement, service, and ministry.

There may be two types of scholarship opportunities:

- Scholarships awarded annually to juniors or seniors to help with the tuition costs of college credit earned while in high school through a "dual-credit" program
- Scholarships to provide support for costs associated with post-secondary education or training after high school.

Awarding either or both scholarships will be based on funds available and an application process that includes evidence of the high school youth serving and volunteering at church through activities that we refer to as **youth ministry**.

Youth Ministry: The scholarship awards are determined by the level of participation in youth ministry activities. Examples of youth ministry may include: participating in choir; assisting with Sunday school; assisting with Vacation Bible School; reading scripture during services; leading the congregation in prayer; participating in the praise service; ushering; running the sound system or technology during services; visiting FLC church members who are homebound or in the nursing home; or, other activities associated with the church and church community.

<u>Dual Credit Scholarship Criteria:</u> Will be developed if scholarship funds become available over time.

Graduating Senior Scholarship Criteria

- Must be a member of the First Evangelical Lutheran Church—either through participation and completion of confirmation, or from committing to membership during high school.
- Must be actively engaged in the youth ministry and service to the church and church community. To encourage active engagement, the scholarship amount is designed in two tiers.
- Must submit the activity documentation after the completion of each activity.

 Annually, youth and parents will receive an updated listing of activity participation.

Must complete the First Evangelical Lutheran Church application prior to the deadline (April 15) to be considered for the scholarship.
