

The Treasurer's report, presented by Susan Mulder, was reviewed, and discussed. The April Profit & Loss statement reflected month-to-date income exceeded expenses by \$3,760.28. Year-to-date net income exceeded expenses by \$2,507.93. There were no corrections or additions and approved as stated.


