## Continue Wonderful Leadership training "La Callejas" South Area



And I want to share part of one of the lessons that we teach to the pastors and leaders:

"Reflecting the glory of God"

Just as the moon reflects the light of the sun, creation is only a reflection of the glory of God. He tries for a moment to imagine what it would be like to see the glory of God directly. It would be like looking directly at the sun. Isaiah was exposed directly to the glory of God in a vision. In this word image (Isaiah 6), the glory of God is represented as holiness and purity. At the sight of that glory, Isaiah, in his sinful nature, fell like a dead man. If we try to imagine the glory of God, we cannot. It is beyond our capacity our capacity. However, incredible as it may seem, God created human beings in order to reflect his glory! God wanted his people, Israel, to be priests of neighboring nations, to live in such a way that other nations would see his glory again and to be drawn to Him (Deuteronomy 4: 5-8). On an individual level, Jesus told his followers to shine their light so that those who observe it give glory to God (Matthew 5: 13-16). Paul reminds us three times that we are actually going to be the glory of God. In Ephesians 1 He says we are adopted "to the praise of his glorious grace (verse 6). In verses 11 and 12 he tells us that we have been chosen to the praise of his glory. As if to make sure we understand this incredible truth, Paul tells us it says that we are marked by redemption by "praise of his glory (verses 13 and 14). Elsewhere, Paul tells us that we must do everything for the glory of God (I. Corinthians 10:31). Peter says that we should live in such a way that those who observe us glorify God (I. Peter 2: 11-12). In other words, when we live the way God asks of us, we glorify God. And, God is our glory. Isaiah wrote that "... the Lord will be your everlasting light, and your God your glory" (Isaiah 60:19). There is more! When we live as God created us to live, we become the glory of God. Isaiah said, "You will be a crown of glory in the hand of the Lord, a royal diadem in the palm of your God" (Isaiah 62: 3). The glory of God is reciprocal. Marvelous!. Continue next report.

The other good news is that this week 189,000 more AstraZeneca doses of vaccine will be given, 65,000 people from the health system will receive their second dose, which means that some 124,000 people will receive their first dose, more health personnel, firefighters, police and some elderly people around the country will benefit. And I want to share with you a great joy for us, after much sacrifice and effort, Sharon our daughter successfully finished her defense of professional practice. All these days had been very difficult due to various circumstances but God in his mercy has answered our prayers! Sharon is a warrior in this life in every way! we are proud of her! And please pray for her, she and also grateful with all of you in Canada for your love and prayers, you are part of this great joy, God bless your lives and all your families even more! love you dear brothers and sisters.
