Consequently, I commend and pray God's blessings upon each ministry, leader, and participant (those involved) for allowing the Lord to use you to enable thousands to experience a Merry CHRISTmas.

BE SAFE!

We are still amid a pandemic that most of us became aware of about two years ago. The Omicron variant is allegedly more infectious than any previous variant of Covid 19 even though it seems to be not as harmful. As your Pastor, I am closely observing everything that is a potential hazard to our congregation, and I plan to disclose more about this in person very soon. In the meantime, I encourage us to be more mindful than ever regarding our safety protocol.

to arrive at least 10 minutes beforehand to be seated safely and comfortably. <u>Temperatures</u> are checked, <u>hand sanitizing</u> is urged, <u>social distancing</u> is applied regarding where people shall sit and walk, <u>wearing a mask</u> is now mandatory in our county, <u>utilization of restrooms</u> is restricted to 2-4 people at a time (depending on the size of the restroom), and <u>congregating before and after Services</u> is prohibited. <u>If you have any Covid symptoms</u> (such as cold or flu), please view and participate in our online worship via YouTube or Facebook rather than in-person worship.
