New Hope has a Safe Sanctuary Policy designed to keep children safe. A copy of the policy is on the announcements strip in the hallway outside the Pastor's Office. Children are not permitted to be on the playground or in other areas of the church at any time without a parent accompanying them. Once in the nursery or class, children <u>must remain</u> there until parents come to pick them up.

**Church Officers –** the following committees/positions need filled:

Finance Committee (treasurer, Admin Board chair, Trustee chair, financial secretary, SPR chair, and lay delegate) (1 open seat): funds ministries that nurture people in their faith. Meets on an as-needed basis

SPR Committee (lay leader, lay delegate, 7 other members) (3 open seats, for a 3 year term): establishes, evaluates, and sustains the ministry focus of the pastor (and staff) in relationship with the congregation. Meets quarterly.

Board of Trustees (chair and 8 other members) (3 open seats, for a 3 year term): responsible for helping the church run effectively and providing a secure environment for worship and mission. Meets quarterly or as-needed.

Administrative Board (Church Council) meets monthly and is responsible for the overall ministry of the local church.

The Board consists of: Admin chair, secretary, treasurer, finance chair, lay delegate, lay leader, SPR chair, trustee chair, and heads/members of following committees:

Intentional Faith Development (offers high quality, purposeful learning experiences for all ages and stages)

Passionate Worship (offering worship that's alive, authentic, engaging, and life-changing)

Radical Hospitality (praying, planning, and working to offer a surprising and unexpected depth of authenticity and effectiveness in caring for strangers, and people in our church family)

Risk-Taking Mission & Service (alleviates suffering and injustice in the name of Christ).

Nominations/Leadership Development (lay leader, and 9 other members) identifies the congregation's gifts and leadership qualities, develops and empowers people for mission and leadership. Meets at least once yearly. By *Discipline*, members may not immediately succeed themselves at the end of their 3 year term.
