When people are forced to abruptly leave their homes because of emergencies, they may not have time to pack the things they use on a daily basis like toothbrushes or soap. But after a few days without these items, they definitely miss them. Your hygiene kits offer a refreshing daily boost for someone when supplies are hard to come by. Please remember to send \$2/kit to FOS to cover the costs of processing.

SUPPLIES NEEDED:

- One hand towel measuring approximately 15" x 28" to 16" x 32" (no fingertip, bath, dish towel, or micro-fiber)
- □ One washcloth
- One wide-tooth comb removed from the package (found at discount dealers like <u>sallybeauty.com</u>)
 - . Must be sturdy with at least 6 inches of teeth
 - · No pocket combs or picks
 - . Rattail and combs without handles are acceptable, must have at least 6" of teeth
- One fingernail or toenail clipper removed from the package (either one is acceptable)
- One bath size bar of soap in the original package
- ☐ One toothbrush in the original package
- ☐ Ten standard size Band-Aids



All items need to fit inside a onegallon Ziploc type bag. Remove the excess air from the bag and seal before boxing. Do not add any extra items or toothpaste. A tube of extended expiration date toothpaste will be added to each hygiene kit just prior to its journey.
