### 1. Fear of <u>failure</u> keeps us from <u>obeying</u> God.

1 After Jesus was born in Bethlehem in Judea, during the time of King Herod, Magi from the east came to Jerusalem Matthew 2:1

### 2. God's <u>purpose</u> is often different than our <u>plans</u>
