 ¹ But as for you, speak the things which are fitting for sound doctrine.
- ² Older men are to be temperate, dignified, sensible, sound in faith, in love, in perseverance. Titus 2:1-2

Older Men Should Be:

- **□** Sober-Minded
 - ◆ Nēphalios (nā-fä'-lē-os): "not drunken; not excessive; not indulgent
- ☐ Serious
 - ◆ Semnos (sem-no's): "grave, serious, honest; worthy respect"
- **☐** Sensible
- □ <u>Sound</u> in faith, love, perseverance.
 - ♦ Hygiainō (hü-gē-ī'-nō): "healthy, without weakness or disease."

³ Older women likewise are to be reverent in their behavior, not malicious gossips nor enslaved to much wine, teaching what is good, **Titus 2:3**

Older Women Should:

- ☐ Have Reverent Behavior
 - ◆ Hieroprepēs (hē-e-ro-pre-pā's): "holy, priest-like"
- ☐ Use <u>Edifying</u> Words
 - ◆ **Diabolos** (dē-ä'-bo-los): "to slander: Satan/Satanic"
- □ <u>Depend</u> on the Lord
- ☐ Teaching <u>Good</u>

• Sophron (so'-fron): "sound judgment, common-sense; prudent; clear-minded; self-controlled

☐ See <u>Homemaking</u> as a Great Responsibility
◆ Oikourgos (oi-kür-go's): "house" + "energy/work";
□ Be <u>Kind</u>
☐ <u>Submit</u> to her Husband
◆ Hypotassō (hü-po-tä's-sō): "to align or place under; to stand under authority/leadership/protection of another"

 - ◆ Antilegō (än-tē-le'-gō): "to speak back, to speak against; to argue; to be obstinate."
- ☐ Be <u>Trustworthy</u>
 - ◆ Nosphizō (nos-fē'-zō): "to hold back; to take something from one place and covertly/discreetly put it somewhere else; to withdraw covertly; to embezzle."
