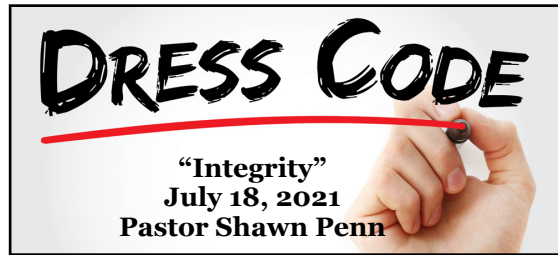
### 3 Tests for Integrity
