**g. Hospitality – The ability to serve others lovingly and with compassion.**

**XI. Manifestation Gifts Defined**

- a. Word of \_\_\_\_\_ – A supernatural utterance of a specific word gained at a specific time providing God’s wisdom to a specific situation.**
- b. Word of Knowledge – The impartation to a member of the Body of Christ with information that will assist the church at specific time of need.**
- c. \_\_\_\_\_ of Spirits – A manifestation given to a member of the Body of Christ for distinguishing between good and evil.**

- d. Faith – An extraordinary confidence in God’s promises, power and presence.
- e. Gifts of Healings – A manifestation where God brings supernatural healing to the sick.
- f. \_\_\_\_\_ – The manifestation of supernatural power that authenticates the ministry of God’s Word.
- g. Tongues – The manifestation of the Spirit that enables the speaker to speak in a language he does not understand and is incomprehensible to the hearers.
- h. \_\_\_\_\_ of Tongues – The manifestation of the Spirit that accompanies the gift of tongues and gives meaning for the hearers.
- i. Prophecy – The manifestation of a spontaneously uttered word from the Lord that gives \_\_\_\_\_, edification or exhortation to the church.
