CHRISTMAS PRESENT: Remember the Lord's steps [and walk in them].

The word *communion* is an action word which means: *fellowship*, *participate in*, *share together*, *have in common*. The observance is not simply keeping a dead memory alive. It is entering into the presence of one who lived, died, was raised from the dead by the power of God, and is alive forevermore.

Above all that He is present with us always and is represented here and now—at the table. Christmas should be much more about *this table* than *yonder stable*.


