HARVESTER'S FOOD DISTRIBUTION

The WAG Harvesters' food distribution is scheduled for the 3rd Mon of each month. Harvesters' mission is to feed hungry people today and work to end hunger tomorrow. We are a regional food bank serving a 26-county area of northwestern Missouri and northeastern Kansas. Harvesters provides food and related household products to more than 760 not-for-profit agencies including emergency food pantries, community kitchens and food distribution sites, homeless shelters, children's homes and others.
