Position Summary:

- Cooperate in semiannual performance reviews by the Personnel Committee
- Become a member of Washington Presbytery and participate in its meetings and ministries

Statement of Purpose and Mission

The congregation of the Burgettstown Presbyterian Church of Burgettstown, Pennsylvania has been called by God and organized to proclaim the good news of Jesus Christ, to minister to the needs of members of the congregation and residents of the community, and to promote peace and justice in the world. This congregation is organized for the purpose of supporting worship of Almighty God and instruction in the Christian religion, according to the Constitution of the Presbyterian Church (USA). Our mission is to introduce our community to Jesus Christ and to grow in our relationship with Him as Lord and Savior through obedience and discipleship.

Church Description

Westminster Presbyterian Church merged with Hillcrest Presbyterian Church in 1999 and became the present Burgettstown Presbyterian Church. The Burgettstown location was built in 1873 and is located on State Route 18, 30 minutes North of Washington, is approximately 10 minutes to WV, and 15 minutes to OH. Services can be attended in-person or via Zoom.

Total active membership as of 12/31/2021 is 94. Our congregation would best be described as an older congregation with a mixture of senior citizens, middle-aged members, and a few younger families. We celebrate Holy Communion monthly, and we have a well-attended Christmas Eve Candlelight service. Average in-person attendance is approximately 35 and zoom attendance is approximately 20.

We currently have an active Adult Sunday school and Children's Sunday school.

Community outreach and mission work is ongoing through our Good Samaritan fund, annual "Coat Give Away" and "Christmas Giving Tree", "Free Produce Give Away", and the knitting and crocheting group - Connected Threads.
