2023 PW in the Synod MISSION PROJECT- Welcome Home SIS

Welcome Home SIS - A Safe Space for System Impacted Survivors is a Christian-based transitional housing and re-entry program that helps women who have been released from incarceration rebuild their lives. The program receives NO government funding. Since 2020, the program has helped 30 women and 19 children.

-Immediate Needs: Transportation from prison to the house, clothing (usually women come out of prison with only their prison sweats), and a nice lunch.

-Basic Human Needs - safe housing (rent) and food.
The women begin to pay rent after they get a job.

Critical Needs for Bo Entry: Dignity Base with pipe.

-Critical Needs for Re-Entry: Dignity Bags with nice hygiene items; Identity Package for State Identification Card and sometimes birth certificates; and Advocacy/Benefits to help with case management and career specialists.

-Get Fresh Garden program to help provide fresh fruits and vegetables.
