### Education and Enrichment for Ruling Elders in the PC(USA)

The presbytery is responsible for providing worship, preaching, celebration of the sacraments, pastoral care, and leadership for its churches. To provide proper training for authorized persons to preach and lead worship and offer other pastoral functions for churches, the Presbyteries of Redstone, Washington, Upper Ohio Valley, Pittsburgh, and Beaver Butler, have joined together to provide a quality educational program.

The purpose of the program is to provide opportunities for spiritual enrichment, as well as to train lay people in preaching and church leadership. Smaller churches in the presbyteries are looking for part-time pastors (CPs/CREs) to lead them. Some prefer having several preachers fill their pulpit on a rotating basis. They rely on Authorized Preachers to do that. Churches of all sizes have a need to fill the pulpit for a week here and there. Again, this is a chance for an Authorized Preacher to minister to a congregation. Larger churches may feel a need for someone to take on a particular ministry such as visiting the shut-ins. There is a need for people to pastor to the elderly in various care settings. There are increasing opportunities for Commissioned Pastors (CPs) to have a place in ministry.

But also, this is available education and enrichment for <u>all</u> elders in our Presbyterian Church (USA).

Do you feel that God is calling you to a type of ministry serving churches week by week or as a commission? Do you feel this could be a vocation where you belong?

### How the Program Works

There are three components to this 4-semester program.

### 1. Courses (all four (4) are required)

These classes have face-to-face meetings at least three times during the 15-week term. There will be online assignments also. They will be common to the whole cohort.

Intro to Reformed Theology	Term 3
Intro to Reformed Worship/Sacraments	Term 4

### **<u>2. Workshops</u>** (participate in six (6); four (4) are required)

A variety of workshops will be led on a rotating basis. The format will be a 3-hour session on one day. You may attend the workshop on the date that best suits your schedule. These may be taken simultaneously with the Courses.
