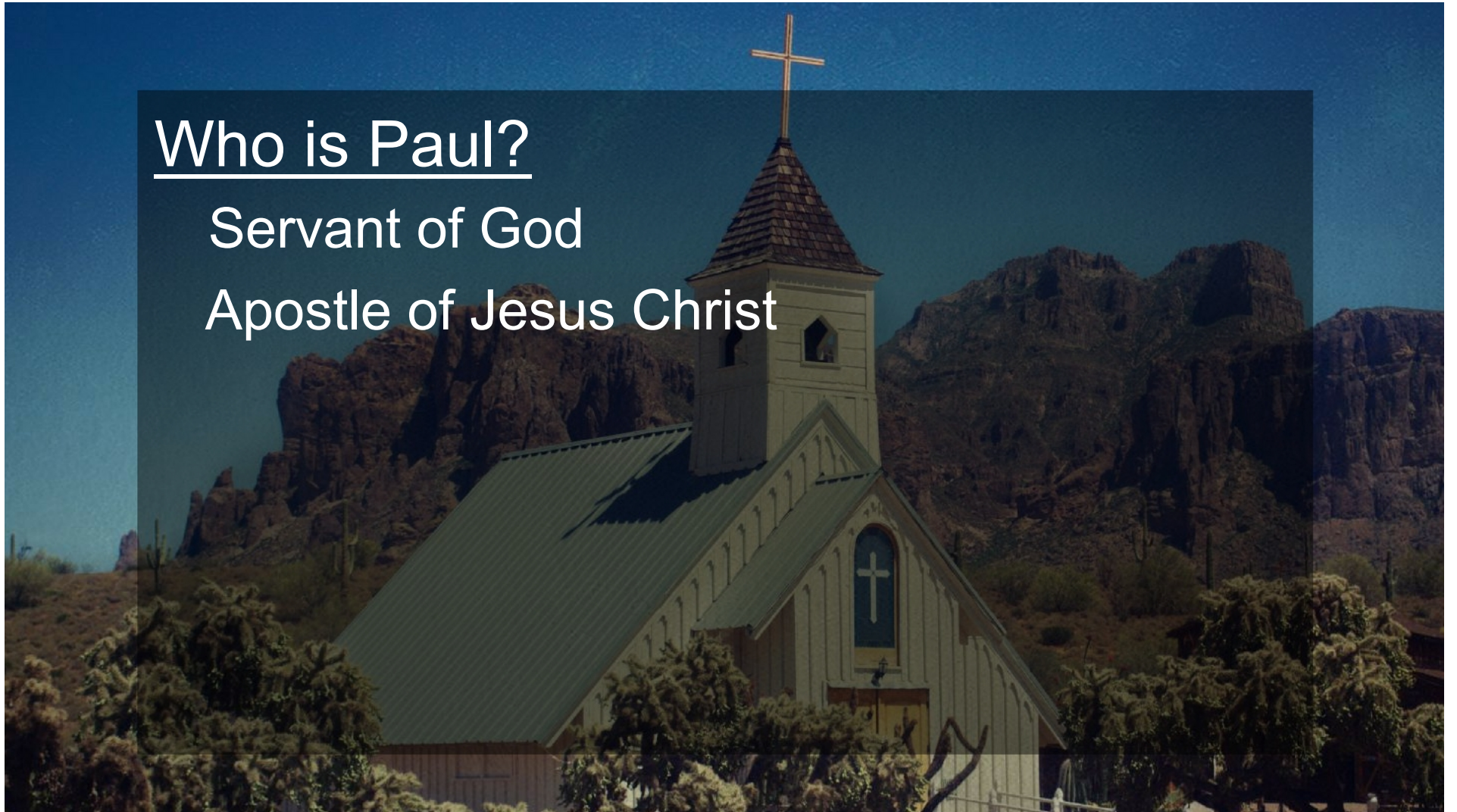
Titus 1:1-4 (ESV)

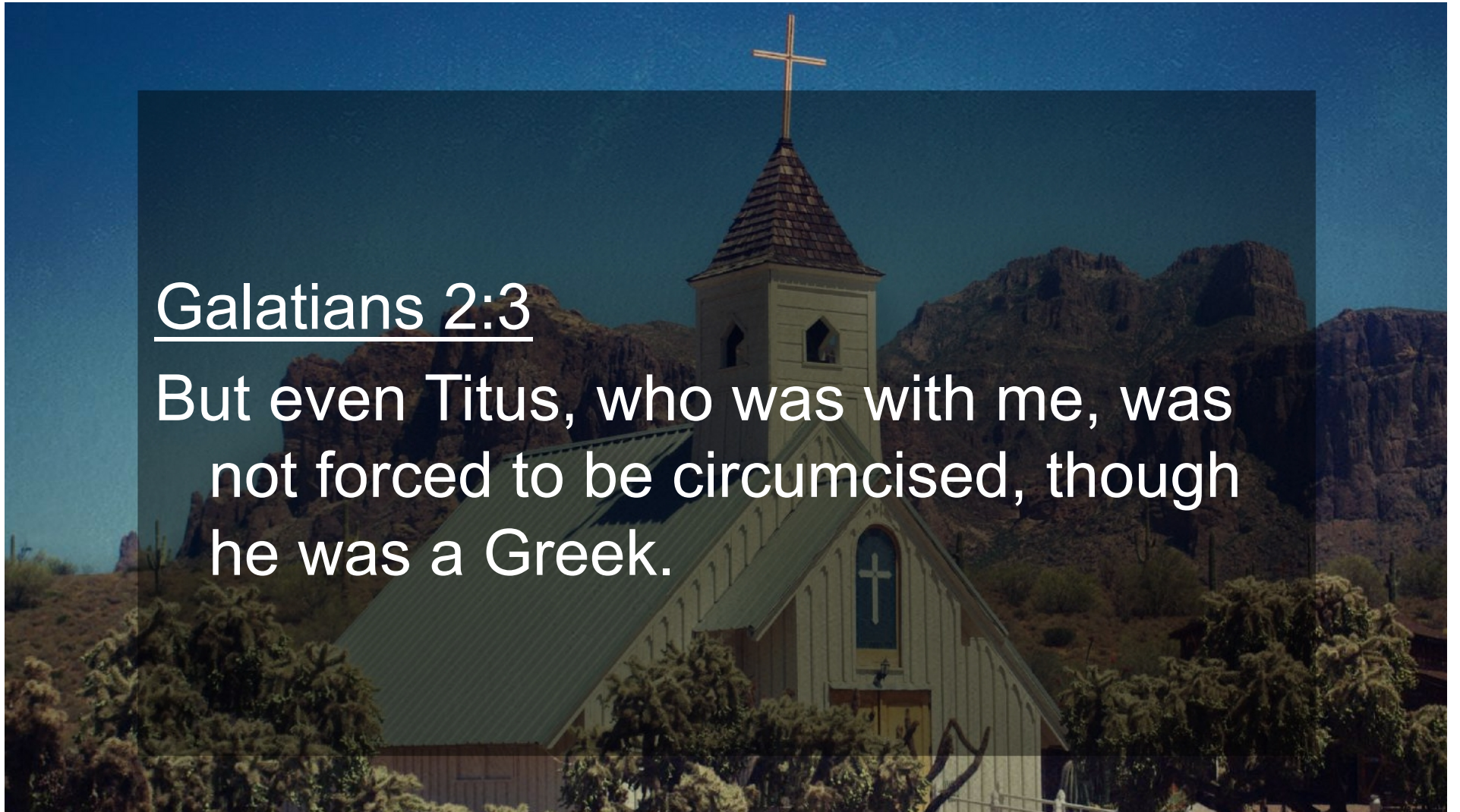

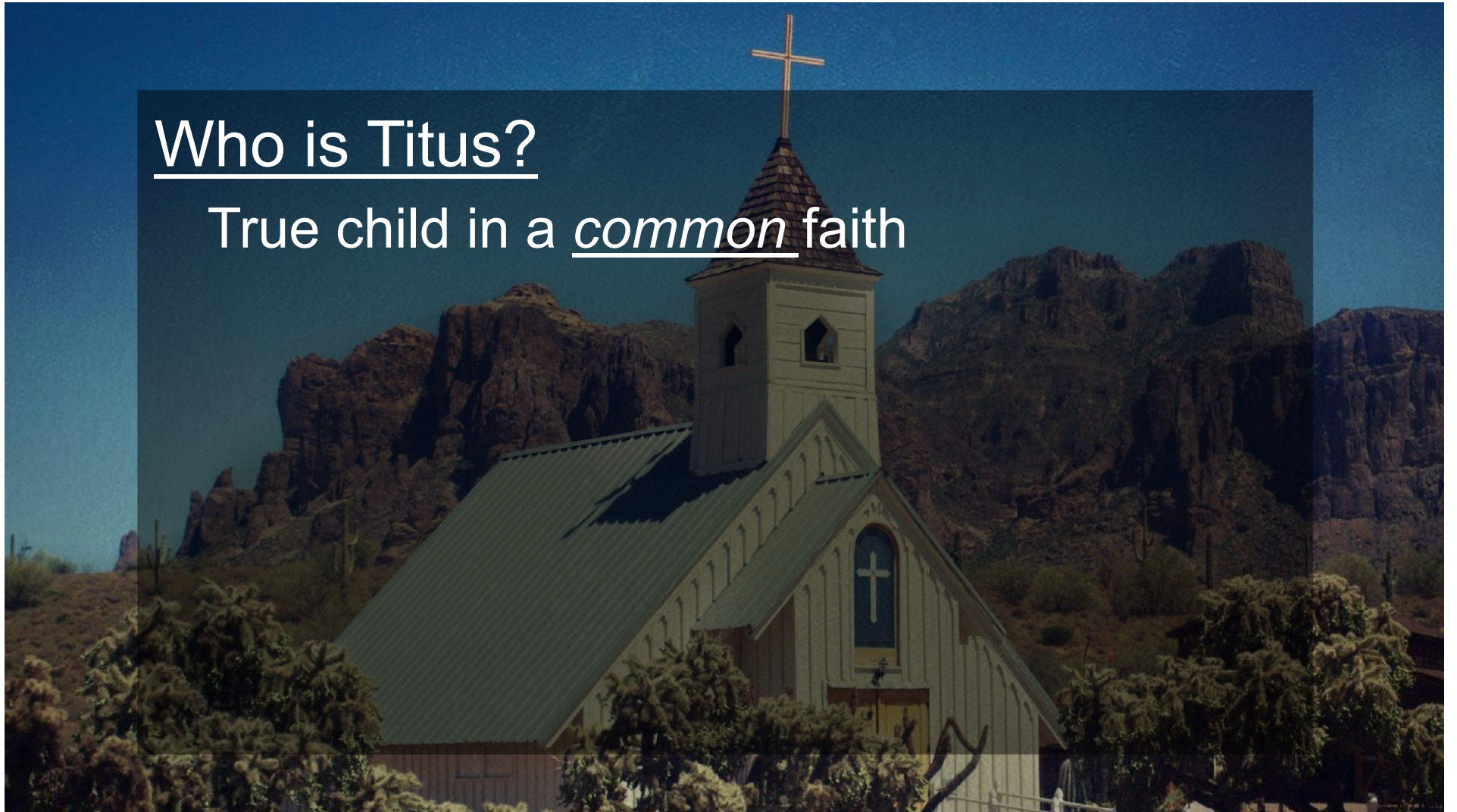
