# Q. 4. WHAT IS THE WORD OF GOD?

- All Scripture is breathed out by God.
- God's Word is true.

All Scripture is breathed out by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness, that the man of God may be complete, equipped for every good work.

**2 Timothy 3:16-17 ESV** (August 1, 2021)

For it would have been better for them never to have known the way of righteousness than after knowing it to turn back from the holy commandment delivered to them.

2 Peter 1:21 ESV (August 8, 2021)

To the teaching and to the testimony! If they will not speak according to this word, it is because they have no dawn.

**Isaiah 8:20 ESV** (August 15, 2021)

Do not think that I have come to abolish the Law or Prophets; I have not come to abolish them but to fulfill them. For truly, I say to you, until heaven and earth pass away, not an iota, not a dot, will pass from the Law until all is accomplished.

#### What is the Word of God?

The Scriptures of the Old and New Testaments, being given by divine inspiration, are the Word of God, the only infallible rule of faith and practice.

God's Word is infallible-this means that it will never lead us astray in what it teaches. God's Word is divinely inspired-it came from God to us through the Holy Spirit to teach us how to think, feel, and act.

As a family this month discuss the difference between the Old and New Testament- what stories are they familiar with in each? Review the books of the Bible that they have been working on learning and discuss which are in the Old Testament and which are in the New Testament.

Discuss what truths you can hold on to-infallible truths. What are things that you once believed to be true but later learned they were false?

Reflect as a family on the infallible Word of God.



1 TIMOTHY 1:1-2

#### **BIG IDEA**

The letter to Timothy from Paul begins with a strong emphasis on God and Christ Jesus. It is important to understand that all authority belongs to God. This means that all of Paul's instructions in this letter come from God to Timothy. Timothy is to guard the Church by being obedient to God's instructions through Paul.





#### **BIG IDEA**

Paul warns about the false teachers and their influence upon the church in Ephesus. These false teachers had replaced the gospel with other useless teachings. This cannot continue if the church is going to thrive. The gospel is our central message and what we are most committed to sharing.




#### **AUGUST 15, 2021**

#### **BIG IDEA**

In this passage Paul recognizes his sinful nature and the mercy poured out by Christ. Paul reminds us that our sin does not disqualify us for God's work. For Christ came into the world to save even the worst of sinners in order to show us the greatness of his mercy.





#### **BIG IDEA**

Paul teaches that we are to pray for all people in all circumstances and that as followers of Christ we are to live peaceful lives to demonstrate the work that Christ did on the cross.

#### **BIG IDEA**

In this passage Paul teaches us the biblical definitions of men in women in contrast to the worldly ones. Men are not to seek out power and women are to flee from vanity and seek good.
