At this moment, we have traveled to two separate communities where 50ish pastors and leaders have gathered to sharpen their skills with one another.

You see these guys (from our American point of view) do not have anything...yet they are faithful. They don't have the latest books or even the good ole books. They don't have comforts, technology, air conditioning, and some of them don't even have a horse...they walk. Yet...They are faithful!

Watching them walk into the conference is like watching battle tired warriors gathering to prepare for yet another mission.
