


9am-1pm.

Jesus asked His firstcentury followers this critical question and He still asks today. In this study, we'll delve into God's Word to discover for yourself who Jesus is and why He matters. Led by Deborah, this study begins on February 2 and runs through April/early May. Cost: \$16.50

WOMEN'S BIBLE STUDIES CONTINUED

Thursdays, 6-8pm in Worship Center and Ark#3. "Prophets and Kings" by Ray Vander Laan. This study explores the turbulent history of Israel's prophets and kings; and draws lessons from their stories that can help build our devotion to and trust in God today by weaving together the Bible's fascinating historical, cultural, religious, and geographical contents. Video is filmed on location. Led by Jai, this study begins on January 28 and runs through February. Cost: none (Optional: you can purchase the study quide on your own.)





Monthly Book Study. "A Lineage of Grace: Five stories of unlikely women who changed eternity" by Francine Rivers. This book contains five novelettes about women in Jesus' family tree (Tamar, Rahab, Ruth, Bathsheba, and Mary). Each was faced with extraordinary challenges; but they had courage. God, in His infinite mercy, used them to bring forth the Christ, the Savior of the world. Their stories hold great inspiration for us today. Led by Sandi. Cost is \$12. The first monthly meeting will be on Thursday, February 11 and runs through June 10. There are two separate offerings for this study:

- Brunch Bunch, 10:30am-12:30pm at Culvers in Fountain (no childcare).
- Thursday Evening, 6-8pm in Ark#3 (has childcare) This session is now CLOSED.

WHERE MOMS CONNECT

Are you a mom? If so, we'd love to have you join us at Where Moms Connect—a Bible-based program for moms of all ages with kids in all stages. **We usually meet the 2nd and 4th Wednesday morning of each month from 9-11am in the Worship Center**. Join us as we fellowship, share in a lesson, encourage, and pray for one another. This year's curriculum is Mom to Mom's *Heart Talk on What Really Matters*. There is a one-time cost of \$20 for the year (Sep-May).



This month's topics are:

- February 10: "Tools for Shaping Self-Worth" providing practical "how-to" handles for building confident kids.
- February 24: "Fences and Flexibility: Setting Limits with Love" covering some Biblical basics of discipline.
