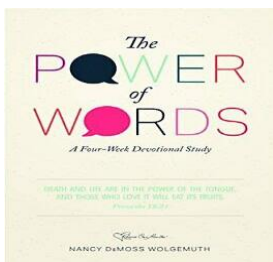

MENTOR MATCH



Our new MentorMatch program gets underway this month. We've held our initial training session for our mentors, and now we are ready to accept applications for mentees. [Lyn](#) is the 8th Street Mentor-Match Program Coordinator. If you are interested in being mentored, please fill out the Mentee Application attached to this email. Please email the completed application to Lyn, give it to Lyn or Jess in

person, or drop off at the church office. Hardcopy applications will be available in the Welcome Center.

- **Program Vision:** to offer the women of Fellowship of the Rockies to opportunity to grow in their walk of faith in Jesus Christ through a woman-to-woman relationship.

- **Primary Responsibility of a Mentor:** to lead your mentee closer to Jesus Christ through fellowship, discussion/devotional, and prayer.

- **Basic Process:**

1. Once Mentee applications have been submitted, Lyn will review all applications, and pray about who to match.
2. Once a match is made, Lyn will notify both parties and the 3-month trial period begins.
3. At a minimum, Mentors and Mentees should meet together at least twice a month for 30 minutes or more.
4. At the end of the 3-month period, Lyn will check-in to see how the relationship is going. At that time a decision will be made to continue the MentorMatch or to reassign as needed.
